2. CRITERIA

- a) To be eligible for the St John of God Health Care - Dr Michael Quinlan Elective Scholarship, each applicant must demonstrate:
- Strong social justice philosophy for developing countries or marginalised groups;
 - Special consideration will be made for students experiencing financial hardship.
- b) You will be required to attach as supporting documentation the following:
- A CV (maximum 2 pages)
 - An elective proposal about your placement, explaining in detail your decision to go to the destination, how you hope to contribute, what you want to achieve when there and how the scholarship will assist you (maximum 1 page)
 - Any documentation that would demonstrate your financial situation
 - A letter of recommendation from the Associate Dean Clinical
 - A letter from the elective location confirming your elective placement

The successful scholarship recipient may be decided by interview.
