Dr Rob Guthrie is currently a Magistrate/Assessor of Criminal Injuries Compensation.

Rob is also the Adjunct Professor of Workers Compensation and Workplace Law at Curtin University in Perth, Western Australia. He holds a B Juris, LLB, LLM MCom and a PhD. He was admitted to practice as a Barrister and Solicitor in 1982 and practised in the area of workers compensation for approximately 10 years before turning to academic research into the area. He was the author of reports to the WA Government on workers compensation in 1991, 1999 and 2001.

In 2011-12 he served on the National Committee to advise the Federal Minister for Employment in relation to Asbestos removal in Australia. He was part of the WA WorkCover Review in 2009. He has been a consultant to WorkCover WA and various Ministers responsible for workers compensation legislation.

Rob is the author of the LexisNexis Workers Compensation Western Australia and has published over 80 articles in peer-reviewed journals.
