### SCHOOL OF LAW - FREMANTLE

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

**Student's are only permitted to enrol in Law elective units if they have:**

- **successfully completed the Core Curriculum Units** – LW104 Ethics and the Law, TH101 Introduction to Theology and **(for undergraduate entry and double-degree students only)** PH100 Introduction to Philosophy.
- **successfully completed all compulsory units within the degree structure up to the year level when elective units are permitted to be taken.** Student's are not permitted to enrol in electives if they have not yet reached the specified year level in their degree. E.g. LLB single degree undergraduate student's commence electives in third year. Student's must check their specific course structure and ensure that they are at the correct stage in their degree to commence elective units before enrolling.
- **successfully completed the specific pre-requisite unit/s** as listed below.

Students who enrol in units outside of the course structure and the above guidelines without approval will not be permitted to remain in those units.
