### **Overview of the Halls of Residence**

The residences are a vibrant and lively place to live. **We are looking for people who want to be and who are committed to living in a community.** The community is a blend of enthusiastic study abroad students, mainly from America, as well as international and domestic Notre Dame students. At times the residences can be a bit noisy, so if you are someone who needs a constant quiet place to study, this is something to consider. The Halls aim to promote and foster a sense of community and respect among the residents through activities such as weekly meetings and meals. Details of the amenities and the structure of the Halls are:

- Co-gender residence
- Single rooms
- Communal bathrooms/showers
- Communal kitchen spaces/fridges/freezers
- Personal lockable food lockers
- Communal living spaces and computer labs
- Internet
- Each room is provided with the following:
  - Bed with linen
  - Bed side drawer set
  - Wardrobe
  - Desk with lamp
  - Alarm clock
  - Bin

While you're a resident in the Halls, the University expects you to respect all of the living guidelines:

- No overnight guests
- No alcohol or drugs
- Quiet hours during weekday and weekend nights
- Attend weekly community meetings
- Complete assigned kitchen cleaning duties
- Attend community dinners

### **Indicative Costs**

Whole semester (18 weeks) **amount needs to be paid before you move in.**

\$3,300.00 (18 weeks @ 175/week + \$150.00 bond)

\$150.00 at the time of placement acceptance

\$3,150.00 paid by Friday 12 February 2010
