DOMESTIC FEE PAYING (NON COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED)

The University of Notre Dame Australia is essentially a privately funded university. The income derived from tuition fees enables the university to employ outstanding staff, to maintain relatively small class sizes, to emphasise excellence and to sustain a high level of personal service to students. The fee structure has been designed to provide access for students who wish to pursue their tertiary education within this unique Catholic institution.

INDICATIVE DOMESTIC COURSE WORK FEES

All fees shown in this document are "indicative" of a full time load in the specified discipline areas. Fees will vary based on the number and type of units chosen. Courses that have an overload component will attract higher annual fees.

Commonwealth Supported Students

Most students in undergraduate Teaching, Nursing and Medicine will be allocated a Commonwealth Supported Place, these fees are aligned with the student contribution rates set by the Australian Government.
