Current Accreditation Framework for Catholic Schools (August 2003)

Teachers new to the Catholic system employed on or after 1 January 2005 will be required to commence *Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School* and have this accreditation completed within five years of appointment.

Completion of **three** approved tertiary units (in the fields of Religious Education, theology or scripture) or their equivalent (e.g., six Content of Religious Education courses) within five years of appointment.
