

CONDITIONS OF THE
CATHERINE KING SCHOLARSHIPS IN NURSING

1. **NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Scholarship(s) will be called the CATHERINE KING SCHOLARSHIP IN NURSING

2. **PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Scholarship is to assist students studying a Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/Division 2 Nursing) at the University of Notre Dame Australia's Broome Campus.

The scholarship is directed towards assisting students whose educational opportunities are limited due to financial or economic hardship by meeting the cost of their course tuition fees and educational related expenses.

3. **VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

The value of each Catherine King Scholarship is \$2,000 per annum. In 2010, a total of two (2) scholarships will be awarded.

4. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:

- i. be an Indigenous Australian;
- ii. be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia;
- iii. be enrolled full time in the Diploma of Nursing on the Broome Campus; and
- iv. be able to demonstrate:
 - a) That their educational opportunities are limited due to adverse circumstances such as financial need; and
 - b) How the award of the scholarship would assist the applicant in addressing the limitations referred to in a).

5. **BODY RESPONSIBLE FOR SELECTION**

The Selection Committee for the Scholarship will comprise:

- i. The Deputy Vice Chancellor, Broome or nominee;
- ii. Assistant Dean of the School of Nursing, Broome, or nominee; and
- iii. Catherine King or nominee.

6. **SELECTION PROCESS**

Selection of the recipient will be based on the applicant's contribution to school and community life as presented in supporting documents and interview.

7. **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- i. Personal qualities and motivation;
- ii. Contribution to school and community;
- iii. Recommendations by schools and employers; and
- iv. Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER) or alternative including: A WA Certificate of Education demonstrating primarily 'A' or 'B' grade averages, Mature age STAT score over 135, TEP,

credit average grades, Cert IV Or Cert III, health industry experience and evidence of successful further studies in literacy, numeracy and study skills.

8. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- i. The Scholarship is open to all students who apply to enrol in Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/Division 2 Nursing) at the University of Notre Dame Australia's Broome Campus and have completed the *Undergraduate Application for Admission* form contained in the University's Admissions Guide.

9. METHOD OF PAYMENT

- i. Scholarship funds will be offset against the recipient's tuition fees. Part of the Scholarship funds, as determined by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Broome, will be paid directly the student to assist with educational related expenses.
- ii. Instalments will be paid subject to the student remaining enrolled in the course and maintaining 'good standing' status.

10. DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

- i. Each scholarship is tenable for the duration of the Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/Division 2 Nursing) course for which it is awarded.
- ii. If in any year, there are no applicants of sufficient merit, no Scholarship will be awarded.
- iii. Normally the Catherine King Scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other external or University scholarship. Approval for concurrent scholarships may be granted in exceptional circumstances, with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

11. NO FEE-HELP OR FEE ASSISTANCE

The Scholarship is to cover the tuition fees of the recipient. The recipient must not enter into any other FEE-HELP or Fee Assistant arrangement to cover the cost of tuition fees.

12. PRIVACY

The University is committed to the principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the Act) and the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (Commonwealth) and will not disclose any personal information (as defined in the Act) relating to this scholarship to any third party without the written consent of the applicant
