Event	Date(s)	Comments
Arrival of Semester 2 Study Abroad students (Fremantle Campus)	Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> July	Semester 2 (US Fall) students are asked to arrive on Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> July. The residences will not be open until this day (Fremantle Campus).
Orientation - Residential Life; Academic Matters; Student Life	Wednesday 21 <sup>st</sup> July	Orientation sessions will be held Wednesday through to Friday. These will include an Introduction to the University, Student & Residential Life, and living in Fremantle.  An Academic orientation will cover all academic matters including any relating to enrolment (registration), which will have been sent to UNDA 3-4 months prior to arrival.  UNDA registers students with the compulsory Australian Overseas Student Health Cover and insurance cards will be issued during Orientation.
Welcome Mass (Fremantle Campus)	25 <sup>th</sup> July	Mass is celebrated in the University Chapel and provides an opportunity for students to meet with members of the local Fremantle community (Fremantle Campus).
Classes Commence	26 <sup>th</sup> July	
Last Drop/Add Day for changes to subject enrolments	6 <sup>th</sup> August	This is the last date by which students can drop or add a course for their enrolment. Students may not withdraw from courses after this date. In practice, there are some classes which will not accept students in the second week of semester. Students are therefore encouraged to finalise classes in the first week.
Confirmation of Enrolment.	9 <sup>th</sup> August	Students sign Confirmation of Enrolment forms which are sent to their home universities.
Non Teaching/Essay Preparation Week	27 <sup>th</sup> September – 1 <sup>st</sup> October	Please note that the field trip for AL375 Aust. History and Society may, in part, be conducted during this break so students should not make travel plans before dates are finalised in week 2 of semester (Fremantle Campus only).
Broome Field Trip	To be advised	Exact dates cannot be given to students until Week 2 or 3 of Semester as they are subject to weather conditions.
