Event	Date(s)	Comments
Arrival of Semester 1 Study Abroad students	14 th /15 th February	Semester 1 students are asked to arrive on Saturday 14th or Sunday 15th February. The residences will not be open until these days.
Orientation – Academic orientation Intro to Student & Residence Life – sports, clubs, volunteering, campus ministry, counselling Living in Fremantle	Week of 16 th February	Orientation sessions will be held throughout the week. These will include an Introduction to the University, Student & Residential Life, and living in Fremantle. An Academic orientation will cover all academic matters including any relating to enrolment (registration), which will have been sent to UNDA 3-4 months prior to arrival. UNDA registers students with the compulsory Australian Overseas Student Health Cover and insurance cards will be issued during orientation.
Welcome Mass	22 nd February	Mass is celebrated in the University Chapel and provides an opportunity for students to meet with members of the local Fremantle community (Fremantle campus).
Classes Commence	23rd February	
Last add/drop date	6 th March	This is the last date by which students can drop or add a course for their enrolment. Students may not withdraw from courses after this date. In practice, there are some classes which will not accept students in the second week of semester. Students are therefore encouraged to finalise classes in the first week.
Confirmation of Enrolment.	Week of 9 th March	Students sign Confirmation of Enrolment forms which are sent to their home universities.
Easter	10 th – 13 th April	The University will be closed on Good Friday and Easter Monday.
Non-teaching and essay preparation week	Week of 13 th April	Please note that the field trip for AL375 Aust. History and Society may, in part, be conducted during this break so students should not make travel plans before dates are finalised in weeks 2/3 of semester.
Broome Field Trip	To be advised	Exact dates cannot be given to students until Week 2 or 3 of Semester as they are subject to weather conditions.
