Event	Date(s)	Comments
Arrival of Semester 1 (Fall) Study Abroad students( Fremantle Campus)	19 <sup>th</sup> or 20 <sup>th</sup> July	Semester 2 (US Fall) students are asked to arrive on Saturday 19 <sup>th</sup> or Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> July.  The residences will not be open until these days (Fremantle Campus).
Orientation - Residential Life; Academic Matters; Student Life	21 <sup>st</sup> - 25 <sup>th</sup> July	Orientation sessions will be held for each student residence.  Academic matters are discussed in detail during the orientation period. Students will be expected to have made their course selections and have obtained their Academic Advisor's approval so that enrolments reach Notre Dame by October, 2007 (for Semester 1/US Spring) and late/April early May, 2008 (for Semester 2/US Fall).  Students will be registered for the compulsory Australian Overseas Health Cover. Upon arrival, students will be introduced to Sporting, Student Life and Community Service opportunities available at the University.
Welcome Mass ( Fremantle Campus)	27 <sup>th</sup> July	Mass is celebrated in the University Chapel and provides an opportunity for students to meet with members of the local Fremantle community (Fremantle Campus).

Last Drop/Add Day for changes to subject enrolments	8 <sup>th</sup> August	This is the last date by which students can drop or add a course for their enrolment. Students are expected to have finalised any changes to their original enrolment by this date. Students may not withdraw from courses after this date.
Confirmation of Enrolment.	11 <sup>th</sup> August	Students will sign Confirmation of Enrolment forms which will be sent to their home universities.
Essay Preparation week	29 <sup>th</sup> September	Please note that the field trip for AL375 Aust. History and Society may, in part, be conducted during this break so students should not make travel plans before dates are finalised in week 2 of semester ( Fremantle Campus only).
