UNDALR is a scholarly refereed law journal with a double blind review process. It is published annually and contains articles dealing with Australian and international law.

### **Submission guidelines:**

Submissions may be in the form of articles (preferably not exceeding 12,000 words, containing an abstract of 100 words) or legal comments, case notes or book reviews (preferably not exceeding 3,500 words).

Submissions should be in Microsoft Word electronic format using 12 pt Times New Roman font, with double spacing, and should be sent via email to [undalr@nd.edu.au](mailto:undalr@nd.edu.au). Submissions should comply with the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation* ('AGLC') 2<sup>nd</sup> ed and The University of Notre Dame Australia School of Law Referencing Style Guide Summary.
